

2021 Osman C. Hooper Non-Daily Newspaper Competition General Requirements

Contest period is August 1, 2019 to July 31, 2020

Contest opens August 1, 2020

- **Step 1:** You must register at www.newspapercontest.com/ohio in order to submit entries. Registration is required again even if you have entered the contest before. Click on the "Register" button. The Association Code can be obtained by contacting Sue Bazzoli at sbazzoli@ohionews.org or 614-486-6677 ext. 1018. You will also need to verify your current circulation number and this can be done when contacting ONMA for the association code.
- **Step 2:** Tentative circulation divisions are assigned based on circulation currently in the ONMA database.

 Division A approx. 4300 circulation and above; Division B approx. 2501- 4299 circulation; and Division C approx. 2500 circulation and below.
- **Step 3:** Do not enter individual PDF pages if the entry consists of multiple pages they must be submitted as a multi-page PDFs or by submitting URLs. The entry title must be clearly identified in the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form.
- **Step 4**: For entries in Category 2-News Coverage and Category 11-Newspaper Design, **one issue must be from OCTOBER 2019**.
- **Step 5:** Newspapers having multiple publications or editions under one ownership with pages in common (news and/or advertising) may only enter the shared content under the title having the largest circulation.
- Step 6: Please note that there are two Category Types in the drop-down box: By Division and Divisions Combined.

The entry fee remains \$8.00 per entry. Payment can be made online by credit card when entries are completed. **Entries** are not valid for judging until payment is made. Incomplete submissions will not qualify for judging and fees will not be refunded.

Newspaper of the Year Award Requirements and Points Chart

Your newspaper must be entered in 2-News Coverage, 11-Newspaper Design and 13-Advertising to be eligible for the Newspaper of the Year award. Winners are determined on a points basis. The order of finish in the 20 categories below carries specific points. After all judging is completed in categories 1 through 20, each qualifying newspaper is awarded appropriate points which determine the Newspaper of the Year division winners.

Category Descriptions and Requirements

IMPORTANT! Multi-page entries must be submitted as multi-page PDFs whenever possible, or by submitting URLs.

Category 1: CORONAVIRUS COVERAGE – One entry per newspaper

- Submit up to a total of six (6) individual pieces (stories, graphics, photos, editorials, feature stories, etc.) as one package.
- Coronavirus coverage should be entered in this category only, with the exception of the entire editions in Category 2 News Coverage and Category 11 Newspaper Design.
- Facebook/social media posts and explanation sheets may be submitted.
- Judged on the overall impact of the package.

Category 2: NEWS COVERAGE – One entry per newspaper (Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- You must be entered in this Category to be eligible for Newspaper of the Year
- Submit three (3) multi-page PDF issues or URLs: <u>one (1) from OCTOBER 2019</u> and two (2) additional issues within the contest period.
- Judged on the overall quality of community news coverage.
- No special editions.

Category 3: BEST NEWS STORY - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit a single story (sidebar may be included) within the contest period. Entry title must be clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form.
- Judged on quality of writing and reporting and obvious extra effort that sets this news story apart from usual news coverage.

Category 4: IN-DEPTH REPORTING - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit one entire article or series of articles within the contest period. Entry title must be clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form.
- Judged on the depth of reporting on a single issue or series of related issues. These may include investigative reporting, enterprise reporting or an analysis of a subject or issue.

Category 5: BEST LOCAL FEATURE – Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit one (1) complete feature story (include jump), or one entire series, within the contest period. Entry title must be clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form.
- Judged on the overall impact of the feature story or series of stories.

Category 6: BEST LOCAL PROFILE - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit one (1) complete local profile on a person or couple (include jump) within the contest period. Entry title must be clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form.
- Judged on the overall impact of the profile story.

Category 7: ORIGINAL COLUMNS - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- An entry consists of 3 different columns per columnist within the contest period. Entry title must be clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form.
- Only one entry per columnist.
- Judged on the overall quality of writing, clarity and local interest.

IMPORTANT! Multi-page entries must be submitted as multi-page PDFs whenever possible, or by submitting URLs.

Category 8: BEST EDITORIAL – Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit one (1) editorial from your newspaper within the contest period. Entry title must be clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form.
- An editorial is an opinion piece written by the senior editorial staff or publisher of a newspaper. Editorials are supposed to reflect the opinion of the periodical, not any individual. No individual columns accepted.
- Judged on the overall quality of writing, clarity and local impact.
- No division by circulation in this category.

Category 9: SPORTS COVERAGE - One entry per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit three (3) sports sections of your choice within the contest period.
- Judged on all aspects of local sports, writing and photo quality and overall appearance of the sports section.

Category 10: BEST SPORTS FEATURE – Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit one (1) complete sports feature story (include jump), or one entire series, within the contest period. Entry title must be clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form.
- Judged on the overall impact of the sports feature story or series of stories.

Category 11: NEWSPAPER DESIGN - One entry per newspaper (Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- You must be entered in this Category to be eligible for Newspaper of the Year
- Submit three (3) multi-page PDF issues: **one (1) from OCTOBER 2019** and two (2) additional issues within the contest period.
- Judged on the overall look of the newspaper with emphasis on placement and organization of headlines, photos, stories, art and ads. Judges will also consider quality and appropriate uses of color, art and graphics.
- No special editions.

Category 12: BEST PAGE DESIGN – Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit a single or double-page spread.
- Judged on the overall look of the page with emphasis on placement of visual elements that may include headlines, photos, graphics, infographics, advertising, color, etc.

Category 13: ADVERTISING - One entry per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- You must be entered in this Category to be eligible for Newspaper of the Year
- Submit five (5) different ads (print or web), <u>clearly identified</u>, within the contest period.
- Entries should be a full newspaper page PDF with each ad identified or a screen shot of the web page.
- All entries must be a result of newspaper production. Agency produced ads are not allowed.
- No house ads. Ads from special editions or sections are allowed.
- Judged on the overall design and content of paid advertising.

Category 14: BEST NEWS PHOTO - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit one (1) photograph included on the full newspaper page PDF or a screen shot of the web page with photo clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form. Entries will be judged on PDF as it appeared in print or online. We also request a JPEG of the photo to be used for presentation purposes only JPEG format will not be judged.
- Judged on the overall quality and impact of a news photo as an integral part of the newspaper.

IMPORTANT! Multi-page entries must be submitted as multi-page PDFs whenever possible, or by submitting URLs.

Category 15: BEST FEATURE PHOTO - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit one (1) photograph included on the full newspaper page PDF or a screen shot of the web page with photo clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form. Entries will be judged on PDF as it appeared in print or online. We also request a JPEG of the photo to be used for presentation purposes only (JPEG format will not be judged).
- Judged on the overall quality and impact of a feature photo as an integral part of the newspaper.

Category 16: BEST SPORTS PHOTO - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit one (1) photograph included on the full newspaper page PDF or a screen shot of the web page with photo clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form. Entries will be judged on PDF as it appeared in print or online. We also request a JPEG of the photo to be used for presentation purposes only (JPEG format will not be judged).
- Judged on the overall quality and impact of a sports photo as an integral part of the newspaper.

Category 17: BEST HEADLINE - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- Submit the headline with full article and date within the contest period. The headline must be clearly identified on the PDF or in the "Explanation or Cutline" box on the entry form.
- Judged on the creativity and effectiveness of the headline.
- No division by circulation in this category.

Category 18: SPECIAL EDITION OR SECTION - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- This entry consists of an entire newspaper, section, page or series of consecutive pages, including editorial and advertising material promoting a single theme. Submit as multi-page PDFs or URLs.
- The entry may also include any statement the editor cares to make concerning the success achieved and any related examples from one or more issues within the contest period.

Category 19: COMMUNITY AWARENESS - Multiple entries per newspaper (No Coronavirus Coverage Permitted)

- This entry shows how your newspaper brought awareness to a community issue. Examples of last year's winners included topics on school safety, drug abuse, opioid addiction and suicide prevention.
- The entry shall consist of a description of the community need and how results of the newspaper project addressed that need.
- Include all published documentation.
- No division by circulation in this category.

Category 20: BEST WEBSITE

- Websites will be judged on content, ease of navigation, layout, design and advertising.
- Websites will be randomly "visited" no more than once per week by the judge October 19 through December 3, 2020.
- Subscription-based websites MUST include login information in comments section for judging purposes.
- No division by circulation in this category.
